I find the past fifteen years<sup>1</sup> I have worked through relational media <sup>23</sup> frustrates professional narrative<sup>4</sup>. While I do claim to have invented this job I cannot take credit for the occupation as a whole, so will account for my experience in terms of timing and serendipity rather than technical charisma <sup>5</sup>. The "community manager" swept into popularity with an industrial shift from how marketing had up until 2011 managed itself socially, to the internet– which, by the time I entered the "job market" was no longer "I.T." but a mode of public expression. Who knows? Maybe Kaitlin Phillips would be here instead of me if she could not afford a Blackberry and had to "settle" for a wearable camera<sup>6</sup> instead. Anyway, our 'Tahrir Moment'<sup>7</sup> was the result of the labors of a large number of activists, trade unionists and drop-outs.<sup>8</sup>

There's an old adage that says "the only thing easier to come by than money is people"<sup>9</sup>, which points to a level of media attention roughly equivalent to USD 1 million in free advertising nightly. I have not worked on Wall Street in many years, yet I continue to find myself known and sought after for the work of others<sup>10</sup>. Therefore, I'm not going to talk about the 2,000 protesters that descended upon New York's Financial District on September 17, 2011, but will point out that this number is a gross miscalculation. On that day no more than two dozen people were in attendance.<sup>11</sup>

Which brings me to Bruce High Quality<sup>12</sup>. In the seven years we worked together anonymously to establish an alternative framework for arts education<sup>13</sup>, within and against the six-figure predatory loan model, I can recall only one case of miscoordination of work. On one occasion, I discovered that we had the exact same art career<sup>14</sup>. I compared the sources and was astounded to find that our curriculum vitae matched character-for-character<sup>15</sup>. The result of our work together has been far greater than the work we each contributed.

I am an artist<sup>16</sup>. On my 1040 form, that is what I put down as my occupation <sup>171819</sup>. As an artist, it's my job to change the language through the operations of art history<sup>20</sup>. Since the works of living artists on the market vastly outnumber the works of the dead, this program has been my life. I would like to present to you some of the most amateur solutions I've ever made work. Hopefully this makes sense in the context of the role offered and I can format it like a  $CV^{21}$  at the end.
